New LTS Complete Starter Codes

Effective on the April 3 Price List, Big Gain will be changing the number codes of our LTS Complete Starter diets to make ordering diets easier. Previously, diets had a different number code based on different medications used. The new diet codes have a number and three-letter combination. Table 1 at right shows the number code corresponding to the nursery phase. All diets of the same phase will use the same number code. Table 2 below shows the three letter code for the appropriate medication and concentration. For example, to place an order for LTS Phase 1 with Denagard and CTC, one would order 3011DGC.
